Facilitator Role

- Like to be involved but avoid having a stake in it
- □ Conceptual/teaching, i.e. problem solving processes, etc.
- Coaching (looking at things a different way)
- Process observations
- Confidential listener
- Making the implicit explicit
- Facilitate to the ground rules
- Ask stupid questions

Ground Rules

- Participate in the process, i.e. get your own voice heard
- Leave titles at the door
- Speak for yourself
- □ Tell the truth but with respect, i.e. be candid.
- Truth above harmony
- Confidentiality
- One voice at a time; no side bars
- Discussion not debate—use active listening skills
- Stay on track
- □ There is no right or wrong, it is just the way you see it from your perspective
- Ask stupid questions
